The Embassy of the Republic of Cuba presents its compliments to the Honorable Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Foreign Trade and Immigration of Belize and has the honor to inform that the Government of the Republic of Cuba, within the framework of the Cuba-CARICOM Agreement signed in December 2017, has awarded 11 scholarships to Belize for the 2023-2024 academic year, starting in February 2023; the scholarships are the following:

- 8 scholarships in **Medicine**.
- 1 Bachelor degree in Health Technologies in the field of **Nursing**
- 2 **postgraduate** scholarships for graduates of the Latin American School of Medicine (**ELAM**).

The scholarships are intended for applicants under the age of 25, from low-income families and with a level of education equivalent to Cuban pre-university education (CXC or equivalent).

The Embassy of Cuba kindly informs that the whole process should conclude by **October 7, 2022**. The selected students must have all their documents translated to Spanish and duly legalized by the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. (See Annex I). The students must travel to Cuba ten days before the beginning of the academic year 2023-2024.
